COVID-19 Policy Update

We are delighted to announced we will be offering face to face lessons from 25th April 2021

- Please arrive at the lesson time and not too early - there will be no waiting room available. Hand gel will be available on arrival outside the front door. We appreciate you taking your shoes off too!
- A minimum of 2 metres should be kept at all times.
- Only 1 parent/guardian may accompany students to lessons.
- At this time, no physical contact between student and teacher should be made without gloves.
- Parents are asked to wear a mask. Students do not need to.
- Students are to avoid using public transport to travel to the lesson.
- The sharing of sheet music & instruments should be avoided.
- Students & Parents should avoid touching anything in the house especially door handles and light switches.
- We apologise that we cannot offer the use of the toilet at this time.
- We apologise that it is not possible to welcome siblings into lessons at this time of social distancing. If this is prohibitive - please get in touch so we can make a plan!
- All payments should be made online and in advance.
- **Students should not attend the lesson if they (or anyone from their household) have had any of the listed COVID-19 symptoms. They can however have the lesson online via ZOOM.**
