COVID-19 Policy Update

*As life gets back to normal
we are offering face to face lessons
in most instances
with just a few notes of guidance:*

- Please arrive at the lesson time and not too early - there will be no waiting room available.
- We appreciate you taking your shoes off and leaving them in the porch - thank you!
- We will still try to keep a 2 metre distance, diagonally across the room - where possible, and for most of the lesson. Because of this, we ask that only 1 parent/guardian may accompany students to lessons.
- We apologise that we cannot offer the use of the toilet at this time.
- We apologise that it is not possible to welcome siblings into lessons at this time - except when both students are receiving lessons from us. If this is prohibitive - please get in touch so we can make a plan!
- All payments should be made online and in advance.
- **Students should not attend the lesson if they (or anyone from their household) have had any of the listed COVID-19 symptoms.** We now know that with the Delta variant these are more likely to be **headache, sore throat & runny nose** than temperature and dry cough.
- **All students are welcome to have occasional lessons online via ZOOM / FACETIME if they are worried about symptoms.**
